Unite is an event for refugees, local residents around Amerikalaan and volunteers and volunteer organisations.

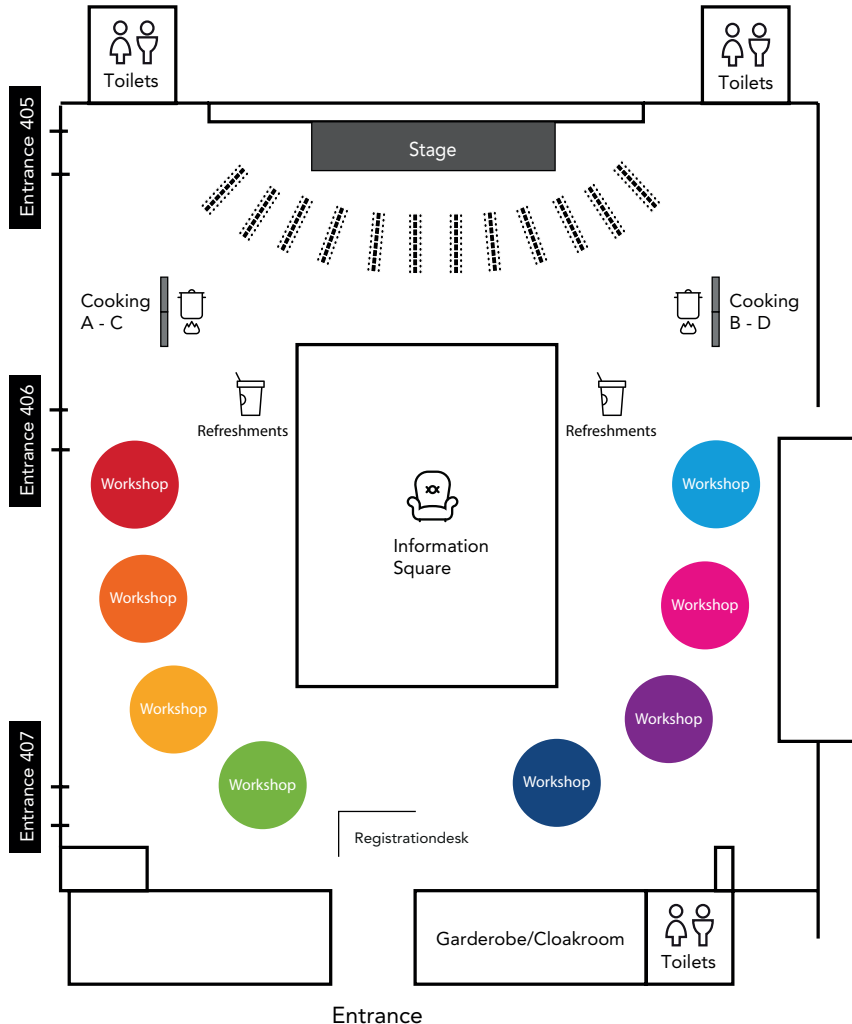
